











Fig. 9-6: The cotyledonary placenta of the ruminants. 1: Chorioallantois (cotyledon) forming villi; 2 Caruncle with crypts enclosing the villi; 3: Myometrium.

Cotyledonary Placenta



1. **Cotyledon:** the fetal side of the placenta

- Placentome:** a cotyledon and caruncle together




The embryonic origin of the amniotic membrane




