

1. It is **NECESSARY** to register to the exam, in order to participate. Bring an ID document the day of the exam.
2. The exam is **written**: all the topics seen during lessons may be found in the exam (please, check the final program uploaded in the e-learning platform)
3. The exam will be on **Mathematics, Statistics, and Physics**, following the above-mentioned program
4. The total score will be **from 0 to 33** (hence it will be possible to gain the laude with a mathematical score of 31, 32 and 33)
5. The test will be organized as follows: **16** true/false theory questions; **12** multiple choice theory questions; **3** multiple choice exercises. The theory questions will be on Mathematics, Statistics, and Physics; the exercises will be on Physics
6. **True/false questions** will have a score of 0.75 points; **multiple choice theory questions** will have a score of 1 point; **multiple choice exercises** will have a score of 3 points
7. The **calculator** is needed. Nothing else is allowed (notes, books). No connected device is allowed (smartphone, tablet, laptop, smartwatch). If you forget the calculator, you will not be allowed to use the smartphone to do calculations.
8. The exam is **passed** with a total score **from 18 (included) to 33**. From 0 to 17 (included) the exam is not passed. From 25 (included) above, you gain access to an **optional oral exam**, by which you can try to improve the score.
9. The **following organization** will be followed: students will register on [segreteriaonline.it](http://segreteriaonline.it) to the exam (dates are already available; times and class will be uploaded on the e-learning platform); based on the number of students, the professor may need to divide the exam in shifts (students' division and the exact times will be communicated on the e-learning platform); the professor will correct the exams, and the day after the exam all the results (only reporting the student's ID, not names) will be published on the e-learning platform; students will have the whole day to communicate the professor if they accept the evaluation, reject the vote, or want to do the optional oral (only for those who scored from 25 above); the day after this, the professor will start register the accepted evaluations and the oral examinations.
10. Students are allowed to **repeat** the exam **BUT** please remember, once the exam is repeated, the previous one is cancelled. So, the valid exam is always the **last one**.
