5. \_\_\_\_\_ : hall used by a group of legislators; many countries have two
6. \_\_\_\_\_ : a committee of the most important ministers in the government
7. \_\_\_\_\_ : the heads of state in many modern states
8. \_\_\_\_\_ : head of a town or city council
9. \_\_\_\_\_ : top diplomat representing his/her country abroad
