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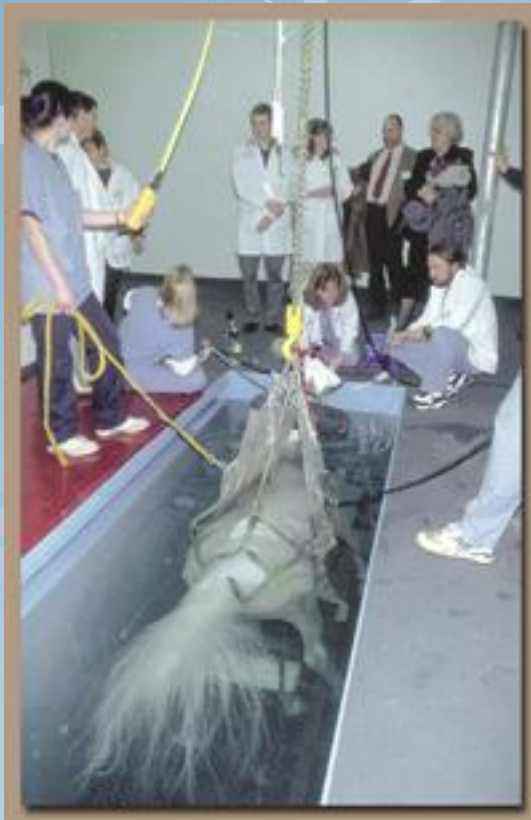




# Laminitis: prevention



# Pain control

## Postoperative analgesia ✓ NSAIDs



Phenylbutazone	4-8 mg/Kg PO q24hrs or 2-6 mg/Kg q12h IV. Do not exceed 8,8 mg/Kg/day (Jenkins 1987)
Flunixin meglumine	1,1 mg/Kg PO IV IM once daily. Do not exceed 5 days of consecutive therapy
Carprofen	0,7 mg/Kg IV, one time (Clark and Clark 1999)
Ketoprofen	2,2 mg/Kg IV once daily for up to 5 days
Meloxicam	0,6 mg/Kg PO once daily for a maximum of 14 days 0,6 mg/Kg IV one time
Firocoxib	0,1 mg/Kg PO once daily for a maximum of 14 days 0,09 mg/Kg IV
